#### **MAPLE**

Maple is a close-grained hardwood that is off-white in color and may have light brown and pink hues. It may contain small mineral veining, light tan or reddish streaks that will darken stain.



#### **CHERRY**

Cherry is a warm, multicolored hardwood. Small pin knots, streaks and gum pockets are common. Cherry wood will darken with age, which gives the species a warm patina.




**RED OAK** 

Red Oak is known for its prominent grain pattern and texture which varies from a light, straight grain to a distinctive arch pattern. Color ranges from white to light brown with reddish hues. Pin knots and mineral streaks may also occur.






